

Addicted To Golf Moving To A New Storefront In York County

YORK-After close to 34 years in business, Addicted To Golf has outgrown its space in the Kiln Creek Shopping Center off of George Washington Memorial Highway and is slated to move soon to a new location in York County.

Owner Richard Schiele plans to move his one-stop golf shop to 5005 Victory Blvd., Suite H, in the Village Square at Kiln Creek shopping center on Friday, January 20.

Addicted To Golf will move to the space that was last occupied by Dress Barn between Subway and Virginia ABC liquor store. The new location will be just a hop, skip, and a jump from Kiln Creek Golf Club and Resort and mere miles away from Newport News Golf Club at Deer Run.

Known for selling top-tier pro golf equipment and offering one of the largest selections of new and used golf clubs, Addicted to Golf provides local golfers with an

indoor hitting cage for testing clubs, club-fitting sessions, and a wide selection of shoes, bags, shirts, gloves, and other accessories.

“We opened in 1989 as an International Golf franchise when I was 24 years old and changed the name when we opened our second store in Williamsburg in 2014,” said Schiele. The entrepreneur said his love of golf was cemented while playing the sport at Knox College in Galesburg, IL.

“We do a lot of used-club business as well as new clubs, and we take trade ins,” said Schiele. “That’s what really helped to build our business because, back in the day, not too many people did that. We still feel like we’re the best place to go if you’re going to trade in your clubs or purchase new or used clubs.”

The new storefront in York County will offer the retailer 3,200 additional square feet to house more merchandise compared to its current location.

“The new location is going to have what is probably the largest indoor putting green in the area,” said Schiele. “The move will enable us to increase our inventory quite a bit.”

This is the second move for Addicted To Golf’s Yorktown branch since it was established more than three decades ago.

“We had been located at the end of the Kiln Creek Shopping Center when we first opened but moved toward the middle of the shopping center back in 2000,” Schiele said.

The Williamsburg branch continues to operate from its original location at 3032 Richmond Rd., Suite 2B, between the Captain George’s and Outback Steakhouse restaurants.

Addicted To Golf takes pride in carrying one of the widest assortments of new golf equipment in Southeast Virginia. It carries Ping, TaylorMade, Titleist, Callaway, Mizuna equipment, and apparel brands, in addition to others.
