The meeting of the York County Electoral Board was called to order at 9:08 a.m. on Wednesday, November 6, 2024, by Chairman Richard Rawls. Others present were: Connie Jones, Vice-Chairman; Sandy Molineaux, Secretary; and Walt Latham, Registrar. Present also were two observers.

(Closed Session)
