Area arts and cultural 501(c)(3) organizations are eligible to apply for supplementary funding for a project or performance that meets the grant requirements. All funding requests must be submitted electronically by completing the official [online grant application](#). The deadline for submissions is March 1, 2025. Pending approval by the York County Board of Supervisors, funds will be appropriated this summer to be used during Fiscal Year 2026 (July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026). 
