**CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN ON BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT  
ON ROUTE 134 OVER ROUTE 17 IN YORK COUNTY**  
*Bridge rehabilitation work with full northbound bridge closure scheduled to begin as early as mid-July*

**YORK COUNTY** — Preparations are underway for a Virginia Department of Transportation project to rehabilitate the Hampton Highway (Route 134) bridge over George Washington Memorial Highway (Route 17) in York County. Contractor crews have been implementing alternating single-lane closures on Route 17 as needed for bridge inspections in advance of construction activities starting later this month.

Kokosing Construction Company Inc. was awarded the \$5.1 million construction contract to perform the bridge rehabilitation project. Work includes the replacement of the bridge deck and approach slabs, as well as minor repairs to the superstructure and substructure of the existing bridge.

The project is estimated to be complete as early as late 2026. All work is weather- and schedule-dependent; therefore, this schedule is subject to change.

**Traffic Impacts:**  
Starting as early as mid-July, a long-term closure will be in place for northbound traffic from Route 134 to Route 17 south for the duration of construction. A signed detour will be in place for northbound Route 134 traffic to access Route 17 south via Victory Boulevard. The on-ramp and bridge from Route 17 south to Route 134 will remain open to southbound traffic. The northbound lane on Route 134 to Route 17 north will remain open.

During construction, motorists can also expect periodic lane closures on Route 17 in the vicinity of the Route 134 bridge.

Motorists will be advised of any additional significant lane closures or traffic shifts that may occur during the project. VDOT will work to minimize impacts and mitigate traffic issues as much as possible. Access will be maintained for local businesses and residences.
