Important USPS Change: Postmark Dates Now Reflect Processing, Not Drop-Off

Effective December 24, 2025, the United States Postal Service (USPS) changed how mail is postmarked. Postmarks now show the date your mail is processed at a postal facility—not the date you place it in a mailbox.

This means delays between when you drop off mail and when it is officially postmarked may occur more often.

Why This Matters

If you're mailing something time-sensitive—like a tax filing or payment—on the due date, you could miss the deadline if your mail isn't processed right away.

How to Protect Yourself

To ensure proof of timely mailing, take your item inside the post office and use one of these options:

- Request a hand-stamped (manual) postmark
- Obtain a Certificate of Mailing
- Send by certified or registered mail with a receipt

Victory Boulevard Widening Project Hits Major Milestone

York County drivers can expect smoother travel along Victory Boulevard (Route 171) thanks to the completion of a new fourth westbound travel lane between Kiln Creek Parkway and George Washington Memorial Highway (Route 17). This improvement extends the right-turn lane at Kiln Creek Parkway to connect with the acceleration lane near Walmart, enhancing safety and easing congestion for motorists heading to Kiln Creek, local businesses, and I-64.

The lane extension is part of VDOT's ongoing \$4.69 million project to widen Victory Boulevard from five to six lanes, add a third eastbound lane, improve turn lanes, upgrade signals, and install a new storm sewer system. Full project completion is anticipated by spring 2026.
